ABOUT THE UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIP

Seniors, juniors and second semester sophomores are invited to apply for the Undergraduate Research Scholarship. The number of awards made any semester varies based on applications and available funds. A student may participate up to a total of three semester's total. The selection committee preference will be to provide the undergraduate research experience to as many recipients as possible.

Students participating in research through Honors Research or Senior Research may participate in this program during the same semester in which they are enrolled for Honors or Senior Research for credit hours.

An average of 10 hours per week spent in the lab working for an average 12 weeks are required for the award semester. Failure to reasonably comply to a schedule as agreed upon with the faculty research adviser will disqualify a recipient from consideration for future awards.

The Undergraduate Research Scholarship is \$750 for the semester. Scholarship checks will be awarded at the end of the semester pending submission and approval of a research report.
